KEY SCRIPTURE: Ezekiel 37:1-3

Ezekiel 37:1-3

¹The hand of the Lord was on me, and he brought me out by the Spirit of the Lord and set me in the middle of a valley; it was full of bones. ²He led me back and forth among them, and I saw a great many bones on the floor of the valley, bones that were very dry. ³He asked me, “Son of man, can these bones live?”

OPENING QUESTIONS:

- What are you celebrating in your life this week? (What are you thankful for?)
- What's challenging you this week? (What do you need prayer for?)

SCRIPTURE: Read the scripture out loud.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

- What might the Valley of Dry Bones represent in the lives of believers?

When in your life have you felt like you were facing an insurmountable obstacle?

What are you able to do because “the hand of the Lord” is on your life?

Why did God want to show Ezekiel that He can breathe life back into dead things?

What testimony do you have of something impossible that God has done for you?

- How can you activate your faith daily?
- How can you help activate other people's faith in God?

PRAYER: Take time to pray for one another. Pray that we would honor God who has breathed life into the dead areas of our lives. May our faith increase in the God who is able to do the impossible. May we encourage someone along the way.
